Pocahontas is a small town in northwest central lowa that provides a comfortable, safe atmosphere for those who prefer a quiet, supportive community. Pocahontas is the county seat of Pocahontas County, located in northwest central lowa.

Our community has six large scale, annual celebrations. There are also multiple smaller events that occur throughout the year, such as the Farmer's Market and Art in the Park.

There are a wide variety of over fifteen active clubs and organizations in the community that residents can become involved with.

Community improvement projects are conducted on an annual basis. Recent projects include the Elbert Park Improvement Project, ADA accessible sidewalks at Princess Park, new holiday season décor, and a new concession/restroom facility at the Elbert Park ball fields.

Pocahontas has seen several well-established, long-term businesses transition to new ownership, and has also seen four brand new businesses open in Pocahontas within the last year alone.
