FOR DEVELOPING OUTDOOR RECREATION FACILITIES

WHEREAS, the City of Laurens is interested in developing outdoor recreational facilities on the following described project for the enjoyment of the citizenry of

Project Title: Laurens Community Pool Project

Total Estimated Costs: \$2,492,620

Brief Description of Project: The proposed project is to construct a new 3,100 square foot community pool to replace the existing Earl Mackie Memorial Swimming Pool which was constructed in 1956. The proposed pool will be located in the local park near other City amenities and will include swimming lanes, a diving tower, stairs for accessibility, bathhouse, and concession stand.

AND, Land and Water Conservation Fund financial assistance is being sought for the development of said outdoor recreational facilities.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Laurens City Council that the project described above be authorized,

AND, be it further resolved that said City of Laurens make application to the Iowa Department of Natural Resources to seek Land and Water Conservation Fund financial assistance from the National Park Service in the amount of 3.01% of the actual cost of the project,

AND, be it further resolved that said City of Laurens certifies to the following:

- 1. That it will accept the terms and conditions set forth in the NPS Grants-in-Aid Manual and which will be a part of the Project Agreement for any grant awarded under the attached proposal.
- 2. That it is in complete accord with the attached proposal and that it will carry out the development in the manner described in the proposal and any plans and specifications attached thereto unless prior approval for any change has been received from the Iowa Department of Natural Resources.
- 3. That it has the ability and intention to finance its share of the cost of the project and that the project will be operated and maintained at the expense of said City of Laurens for public outdoor recreational use.
- 4. That no financial assistance has been given or promised under any other federal program or activity with regard to the proposed project.
- 5. That it will not discriminate against any person on the basis of race, color, or natural origin in the use of any property or failure acquired or developed pursuant to this proposal and shall comply with the terms and intent of the Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, P.L. 88-352 (1964), and of the regulations promulgated pursuant to such Act by the Secretary of the Interior and contained in 43 CFR 17.
- 6. That it will maintain adequate financial records on the proposed project to substantiate claims for cost-sharing.
