Appliances will be free again and will not need a sticker. You can either pay upfront or we can add to your city account. If there is something you are in question about please call City Hall.

The City will be starting Nuisance letters shortly after Clean Up Days so let’s make it so we don’t have to send any. Garbage and un-needed/wanted junk can be disposed of during this time with the exception of the items below. NO Refrigerators, Freezers or Coolers full of food or we will not pick it up. Due to the amount of increased landfill costs we have changed the amount of bucket loads. Starting this year for Spring and Fall we will only be giving 1 free bucket load. For each load after, it will be \$20 a bucket-load. If you have any questions please contact City Hall. Please do not put items or junk out until May 1st!
