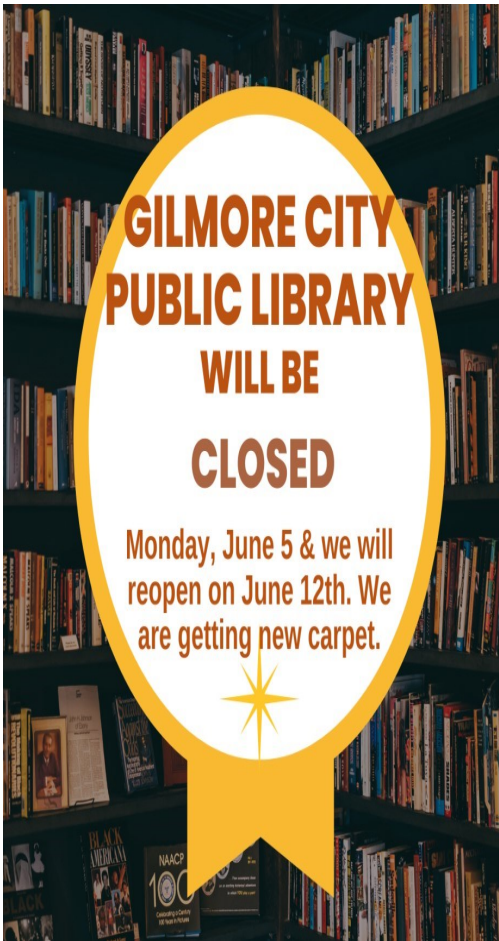

The Pocahontas County Library Association is excited to bring 8 STEAM programs to our youth this summer! Lorna Naeve, Director at the Gilmore City Public Library, applied for a Pocahontas County Foundation Grant on behalf of our organization, and was awarded \$3,476 to bring the Groat Museum to our county. This grant will also help us to purchase STEAM kits for our individual libraries and supply prizes for a Special Prize Drawing for ages 18 and under!! STEAM stands for Science, Technology, Engineering, Art and Math, and is so important to encourage in our youth!

The theme for this year's Summer Reading Program is "Find Your Voice", and we're so excited to help our kids find & express their interests in the Arts and Sciences this Summer!

Our first program is the Rockets Away program, at which we will launch rockets of all shapes and sizes, and will explore the concepts of Newton's Law and Forces of Flight. This program will be presented on Wednesday, June 14 th at Palmer at 10:00am, Varina at 1:00pm, and Fonda at 4:00pm.

Our next program will be the Bubbles program, where we will experiment with bubbles, learn how bubbles work, and find out what you need to do, to make them spectacular! This program will be presented on Wednesday, June 28 th at Pocahontas at 10:00am, Laurens @ 1:00pm, and Havelock at 4:00 pm.

Our grand finale will be the Mad Mixture program, where we will explore Kitchen Science, Super Cold, and Combustion in this explosive combination of science mixtures! This program will be presented on Wednesday, July 12 th at Gilmore City 10:00 am, and Rolfe @ 1:00pm.

Come to as many programs as you like. If you pick up a Pocahontas County Passport at your local library and get a sticker from all three programs (Rockets, Bubbles and Mad Mixture) you will be eligible for a special prize drawing!!
