BURNING OF LEAVES

As a friendly reminder to the citizens of Gilmore City, in accordance to City Ordinance Chapter 135.08 it is prohibited to burn trash, leaves, rubbish, or other combustible materials in any curb and gutter or on any paved or surfaced street or alley. Leaves may be taken to the City Landfill and the guys will burn them when the burn ban is lifted. You will also need to stop and get a key from City Hall.

CURBSIDE RECYCLING RULES:

Curbside recycling is done on the 2nd Wednesday of each month. Items need to be separated at the curb, - so glass all in

one container, paper/newspaper in one container, etc. NOT MIXED TOGETHER. People can use grocery bags, plastic containers, cardboard boxes, etc. If you want to save the container for continued usage, be sure to write "SAVE" on container where our drivers can see it.
