ORDINANCE #2024-02

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF GILMORE CITY, IOWA 2011, BY AMENDING PROVISIONS PERTAINING THE FEES CHARGED TO DELINQUENT CUSTOMERS

92.05(4). FEE TO RESTORE WATER SERVICE TO DELINQUENT CUSTOMER

(A) A fee in the amount of \$50.00 will be charged to the customer if a 24-hour disconnect notice must be posted to the customers' premises.

(B) A fee in the amount of \$50.00 will be paid by the customer along with payment to bring the account current before service may be restored. This charge will increase to the amount of \$75.00 if after regular business hours.

110.05. FEE TO RESTORE GAS SERVICE TO DELINQUENT CUSTOMER

A fee in the amount of \$25.00 will be paid by the customer along with pay-

ment to bring the account current. If payment cannot be made to bring the account current, a payment agreement may be entered into between the City and customer per rules set forth by the Iowa Utilities Board. However, the fee must be paid prior to reinstatement of service. This charge will increase to the amount of \$50.00 if after regular business hours.
