

Rolfe Regular Council Meeting  
Monday, December 9, 2019  
Rolfe Community Center, 5:30 pm

Mayor Tom Andersen called the meeting to order at 5:30 pm and took roll call. Council present Dan Allen, Jon Wellik, Rick Jones, Al Sroufe and Jim Sandvig.

Sroufe/Allen moved to approve the consent agenda including agenda, 11/18/19 minutes and bills. All ayes.

De Sindergard gave treasurer's report. Wellik/Sandvig moved to approve treasurer's report. All ayes.

Council Comments – Allen asked how nuisance houses are coming. Al had question on the Caucus at the gym.

Clerk will be on vacation December 23<sup>rd</sup> – 27<sup>th</sup>.

Utility reports – nothing at this time Tony had to reschedule his water test.

Clerk gave update on nuisance abatements.
