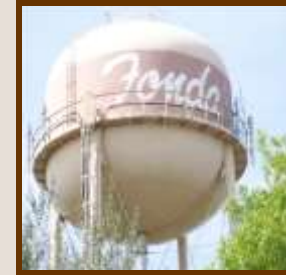


Cabin Rules

- Check-in time is after 3:00 p.m.
- Check-out time is 12:00 noon.
- Guests must be at least 21 years old to reserve or occupy a cabin unless accompanied by an adult.
- Cabin sleeps 4, maximum occupancy is 8.
- Tents and RVs are not permitted at the cabin site.
- Cooking, other than with a microwave, crock pot, George Foreman, coffee maker, hot plate or toaster is prohibited inside the cabin. A grill is provided outside.
- No smoking is allowed in the cabin.
- Pets are not allowed in the cabin and must be leashed or kenneled outside. Pet waste must be disposed of properly.
- Garbage must be taken to the dumpster, the floor must be swept, the countertops, microwave & refrigerator must be wiped down and please put the furniture back the way it was when you arrived.
- All other park rules are in effect.
- The City of Fonda staff has authority to refuse or rescind all rental privileges.

School Park, Straight Park, Lake Marvin & Turtle Pond, Fonda, IA 2022



The cabins at Straight Park have electricity; are heated and air-conditioned; and have a ceiling fan. The kitchen is furnished with a microwave, coffee maker, toaster and refrigerator. Cabinets provide storage and work space. For dining or playing board games, there is a table and chairs. Each Cabin has A full-sized bunk bed (both upper and lower).

You must bring your own bed linens and pillows as they are not furnished.

A picnic table provides outdoor seating along with a wonderful view of the lake and pond.

A fire ring with a grill attachment and a water hydrant are located just outside the cabin. Parking is adjacent to the cabin.

Shower house, restrooms, play ground, open air shelter, walking path and a handicapped accessible dock for fishing and relaxing are just a short walk away.

Cabin Fees & Reservations April 10—October 15, 2022

Sunday—Thursday : \$50/night

Friday—Saturday & Holidays: \$55/night
(Two night minimum stay on weekends/holidays)

Per week : \$350

A \$100 refundable deposit is charged per stay.



The City of Fonda is a community of 635 residents, nestled along the Big Cedar Creek in the southwest corner of Pocahontas County. School Park Campground has 23 full hookups. Straight Park camping facilities consist of 8 sites with water and electrical service, graveled pads, picnic tables, grills and shower house. Some sites have sewer service as well plus a septic dump station is available. The biggest draw to the park is its inclusion of recreational trails, play ground equipment, picnic area, sports facility, pond for fishing and non-motorized water craft, scenic beauty and the abundance of wild-life makes it an excellent spot to spend the day or camp for the week. Other parks, golf course, swimming pool, restaurant/bar and a Casey's General Store are located within Fonda.
